To whom it may concern:

Reliant Park is home to the National Football League's Houston Texans and the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo. The Stadium's four-acre roofing structure, the first retractable roof in the NFL, is constructed using 403,800 square feet of PTFE Sheerfill architectural fabric membrane and two 967-foot long steel super-trusses supported by four reinforced concrete columns.

In January of 2014, Reliant Park contracted ISCC, Inc. for the cleaning of the PTFE fabric roof. Lane Cooper and his SPRAT/IRATA certified team completed the project in just 14 days. We received a visual inspection/cleaning report for our maintenance records and also a digital photo DVD with before/after pictures.

There have been several comments from upper management as well as the Houston Texans and the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo on the difference the cleaning has made. We are very pleased with the cleaning results and professionalism provided by ISCC, Inc. and would highly recommend their services.
